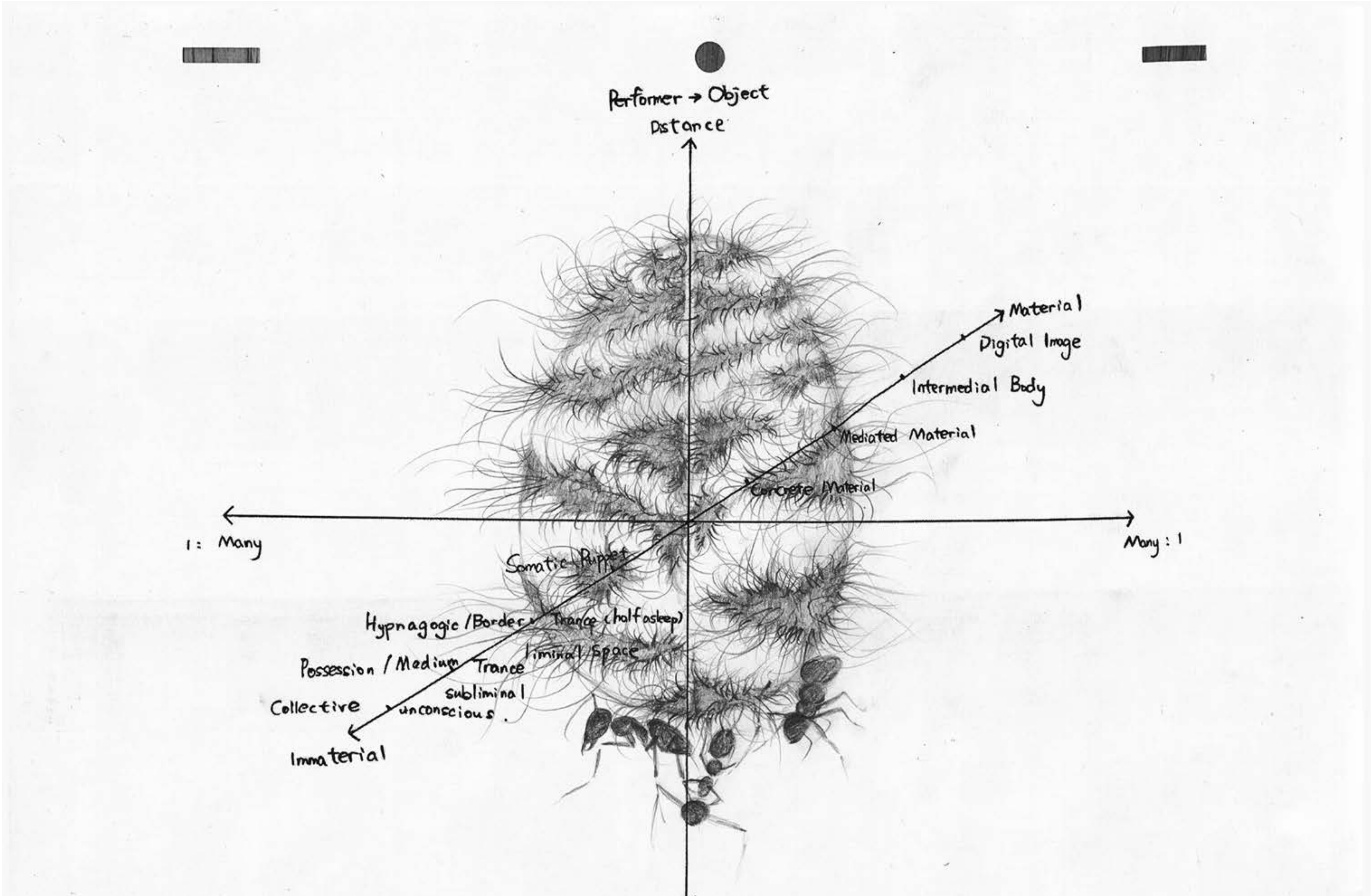
I buried my body. It floated on the surface of the water. My nerve endings quietly escaped from my flesh and spread across the water’s surface.

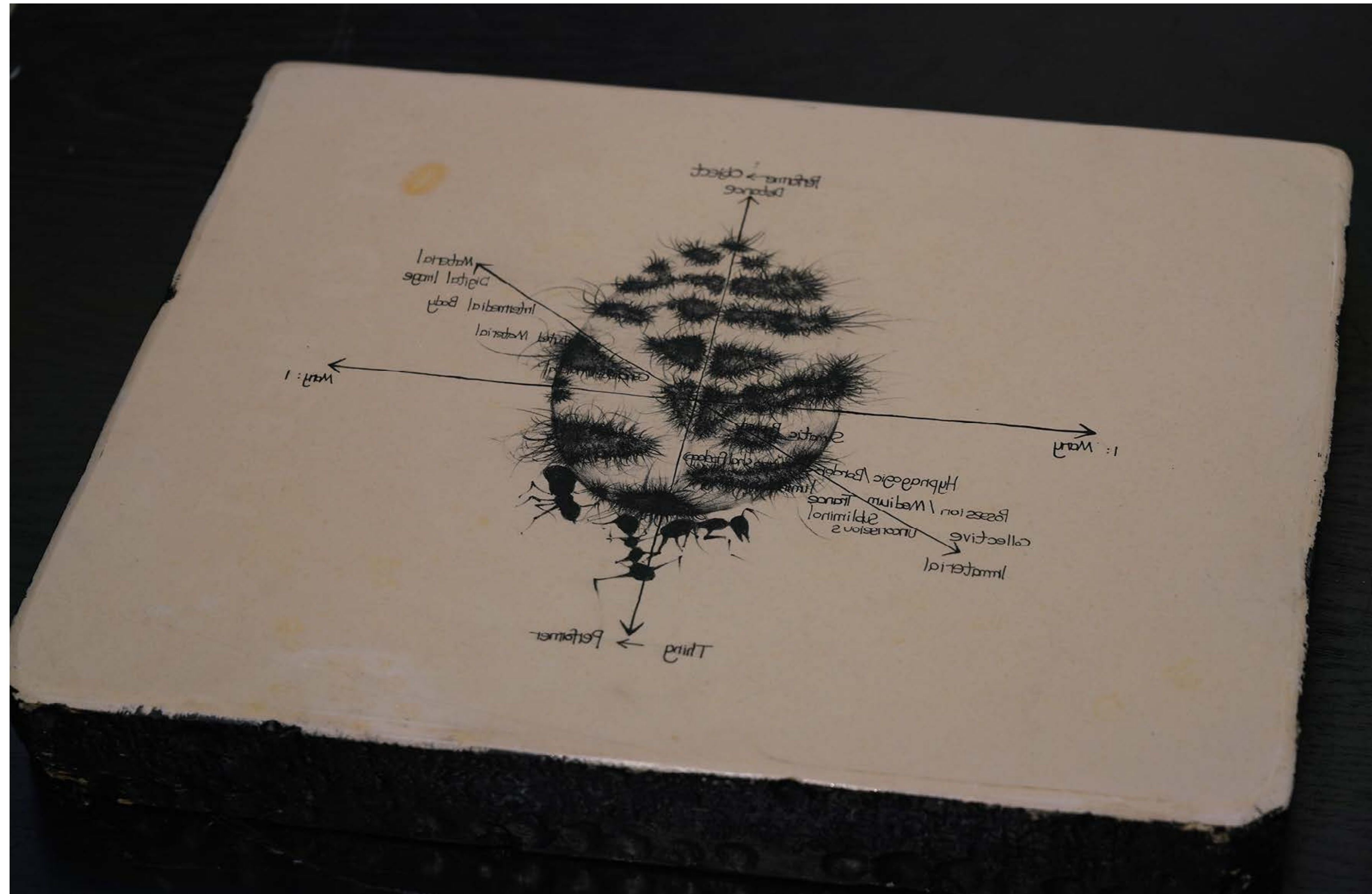

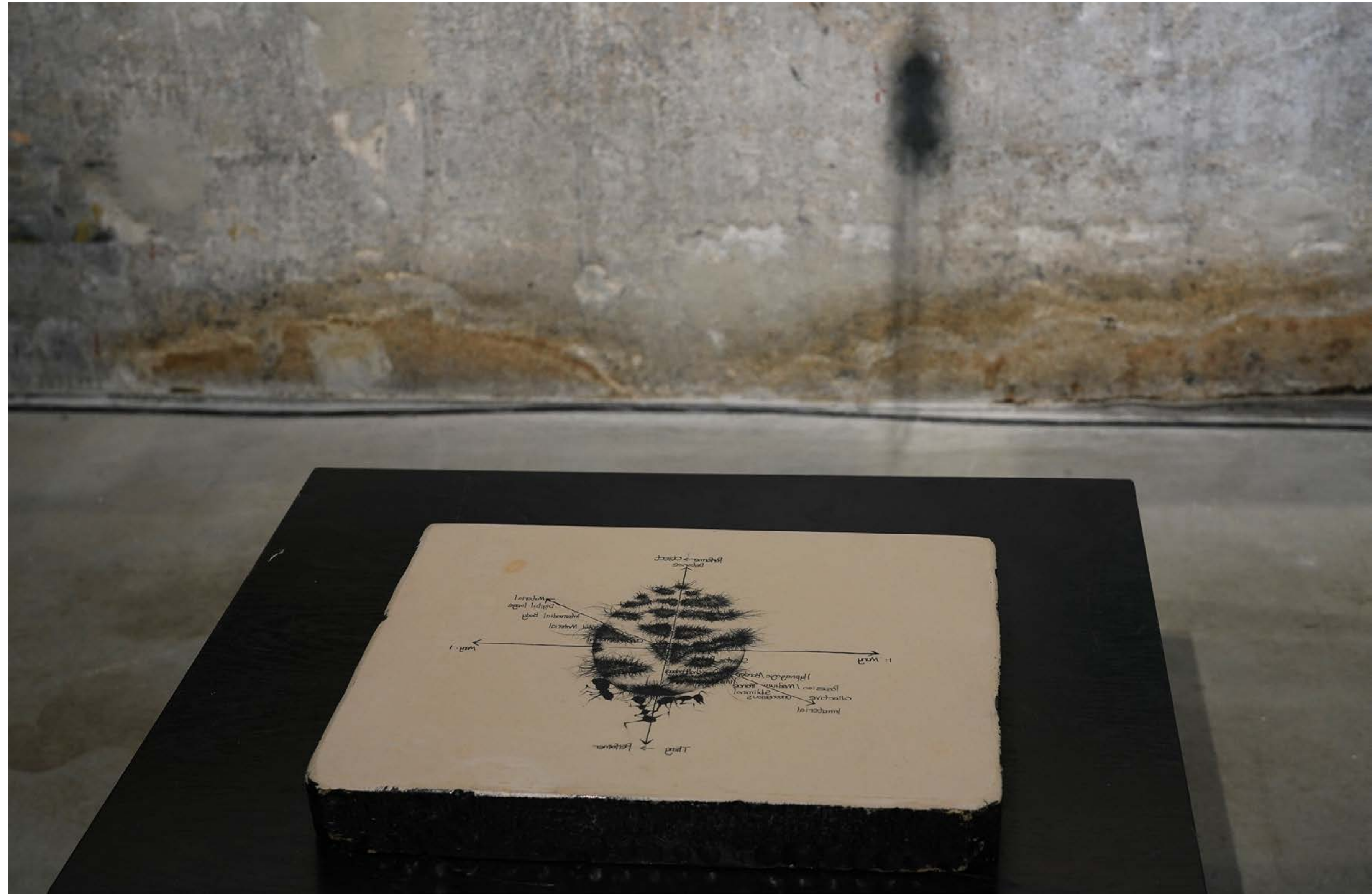
